

127. COMMUNITY TRANSPORT AND CONCESSIONARY TRAVEL

Consideration was given to the report of the Director Designate (Assistant Chief Executive), as contained on pages 1113 to 1118 of the Book of Reports, advising that Lancashire County Council had put forward proposals for concessionary travel provision to be maintained at the position prior to 1 April 2011 (when that authority assumed responsibility for the provision of travel concessions), for a period of three months, pending a review aimed at informing future arrangements. In this respect she reported that the Council's contribution to these arrangements would be £11,151, which could be funded from savings in the 2010/11 budget.

RESOLVED: That funding of £11,151 be provided to the County Council as this Council's contribution towards the 3 month transitional arrangements for free travel on community transport.
